



## Leisure Card Information Sheet

Welcome to all users of the Memorial Regional Civic Centre.

For the 2019-2020 season, the LEISURE CARD is required to access the MEMBERS' RATES.

Users can access all programs and activities WITHOUT A LEISURE CARD at NON-MEMBERS' RATES.

VISITORS have access to MEMBERS' RATES without a leisure card (See VISITORS section below).

WALKERS that don't have a leisure card must purchase a WALKERS' CLUB CARD at \$25 (taxes included).

The leisure card can be obtained at the Customer Service Desk at the Memorial Regional Civic Centre **starting Monday, September 30<sup>th</sup>**, according to the schedule posted on the website ([www.campbellton.org](http://www.campbellton.org)) or at the Civic Centre (506.789.2888). The schedule is subject to change during the season.

### **2019-2020 SEASON LEISURE CARD COST**

<b>Residents from a Partner Municipality</b>	No charge.	The card is paid for by your municipality.
<b>Residents from a Non-Partner Municipality</b>	\$200 plus taxes (Sept – June). \$100 plus taxes (March 1 <sup>st</sup> – June).	
<b>Family Pass</b>	\$700 (plus taxes). \$100 (plus taxes) for additional child.	Includes 2 adults and 2 children or 1 adult and 3 children. Children must be under the age of 18 years old.
<b>Child less than 2 years old</b>	No charge.	Must be accompanied by an adult with a leisure card.

\*\$5 (taxes included) fee for lost or stolen card replacement or for a duplicate – for all of the above

### **PARTNER MUNICIPALITIES:**

Municipalities have an option to enter into an Agreement with the City of Campbellton and cover the cost of the leisure card for their residents. You can verify with your municipality if they have elected to enter into such an agreement.

### **VISITORS**

Person who resides outside of the following regional boundaries:

Robinsonville NB (West), Charlo NB (East), Matapédia Qc (West), Nouvelle Qc (East).

\* Proof of residency required (driver's license, hotel reservation confirmation with dates and name, etc.)

Users must have their leisure card with them at all times when using the Civic Centre in order to have access to members' rates.

**WHAT IS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN THE CARD**

<b>Campbellton residents</b>	Each applicant must provide a proof of identity and two proofs of residency with name and address (address must be the same on all documents). <i>(See: Acceptable Proof of Identity and Residency document)</i>
<b>Residents from a Partner Municipality</b>	Each applicant must provide a proof of identity and two proofs of residency with name and address (address must be the same on all documents). <i>(See: Acceptable Proof of Identity and Residency document)</i> OR Some municipalities offer to provide proof of residency to their citizens according to a pre-established form. When obtaining the leisure card at the Civic Centre, the original of this form will be required along with a photo ID (or two proofs of identity without a photo). <i>(See on City website if your municipality provides that service and/or if getting proof of residency from your municipality is mandatory)</i>
<b>Other residents</b>	No proof of residency required

\*Without above documents, the request won't be processed

\*\* A picture will be taken for the leisure card – all applicants must be present at registration

**LEISURE CARD VALIDITY PERIOD:**

September 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup> (or March 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup>)

(Valid until August 31<sup>st</sup> if the Civic Centre remains open during the summer – 2 months bonus)

**ADMISSIONS/REGISTRATIONS COSTS:**

As per Members and Non-Members Rate Schedules in place at the Memorial Regional Civic Centre.

**MINOR SPORTS ASSOCIATIONS:**

Minor sports associations can opt for a flat-rate contribution to the Civic Centre instead of the leisure cards.

For associations that decide not to take advantage of this option, participants residing in municipalities that do not have an agreement with the Civic Centre will have to have the leisure card, at regular cost.

**THE LEISURE CARD IS REQUIRED TO HAVE ACCESS TO MEMBERS' RATES FOR THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES:**

- **Admissions to public activities**  
(Public swimming and skating, squash, shinny hockey, etc.)
- **Admissions/Registrations to programs**  
(Goldentime, swimming lessons, private swimming lessons, etc.)

**THE LEISURE-CARD IS NOT REQUIRED (BY ALL) FOR:**

- **Admissions to events**  
(Tigers' games, Promotion Plus, Concerts, Shows, etc.)
- **Rentals (unsubsidized)**  
(Ice rentals, pool rentals, convention centre, birthday parties, etc.)
- **Tournaments and competitions**  
(Hockey, swimming, etc.)
- **Training Camps and Tigers' Hockey School**
- **Dance schools, Youth Centre, judo, etc.**
- **Admission to facility**  
(Watching kids practicing or playing hockey, bar, etc.)
