# Memorial Regional Civic Centre Return to Pool General User Groups

### PREAMBLE

The following document outlines the various roles and responsibilities of all pool users of the Memorial Regional Civic Centre. Users must agree to and comply with these requirements and adhere to all following items during their use of the facility.

In addition to the requirements set out below, all users must be familiar with and in compliance with all Covid related requirements outlined by the Province of New Brunswick.

Civic Centre Memorial staff must be respected at all times and in regards to the enforcement of the terms and conditions set out within this document. Any abuse or disrespect towards staff, volunteers, other patrons etc. will not be tolerated.

Non-compliance with any of the requirements set out within this document will result in user being asked to leave the facility, and user fees will be deemed non-refundable.

### PROTOCOL

- Entry to facility for pool use will be through front door of Civic Centre only.
- Entry will only be permitted with proper face coverings that are to be placed on face area before entering building proper and self screening protocol affixed to doors or on entry table read and agreed to.
- Upon entry hand sanitization is required via one of the hand sanitization stations in lobby.

- The province of New Brunswick Covid-19 screening questionnaire (<https://www2.gnb.ca/content/dam/gnb/Departments/h-s/pdf/ScreeningEF.pdf>) will be posted at all entrances to the facility. Anyone entering the facility will be required to self-screen and must comply with the instructions set out within the questionnaire.

## Memorial Regional Civic Centre Return to Pool General User Groups

- After self screening and hand sanitization patron may proceed to CSR for entry fees etc.
- While on the premises of the Memorial Regional Civic Centre (including but not limited to: parking lot, within the arena, common areas, dressing rooms, staging areas and pool deck) physical distancing of a minimum of 6 feet / 2 meters separation will be maintained between patrons, spectators, and employees of the City of Campbellton.
- Non-medical facemasks / face coverings will be required by all users and patrons while entering, exiting and moving about in and about facility at all times, outside of in pool activities. While in pool proper engaging in water activities physical distancing of two meter spacing will be in effect. A facemask will be used at all times outside of pool on pool deck proper in preparation for swimming.
- Only one (1) parent or guardian ( if non swimmer) will be permitted in the building with each participant. Unless it is deemed necessary, it is **STRONGLY** encouraged that siblings are not brought into the facility. Any siblings required to be at the facility **MUST** be accompanied by and under the strict supervision of an adult at all times.
- There will be a maximum of (30) swimmers (large pool) and (15 swimmers) small pool for any one swim session
- For lane swimming (1) person per lane.
- Swimmer are advised to call CSR (customer service) to reserve swim time at Tel: 789-2888 in advance
- Access to pool area from lobby will be through doors at west end of lobby or elevator if required. (One rider in elevator at a time)
- Entry to pool area once on second floor will be through birthday room door. Once there a log book will be available, and all parties wishing to go further on deck will be required to sign in on form which will be used for contact tracing should the need arise.
- These lists will be kept for 21 days as required by Dept. of Health and then destroyed if not needed for a follow up. A new list will be generated for each swim session and secured by lifeguard for archives.
- All swimmers are to arrive at facility with swimwear under clothing. There will be a staging area on pool deck with two meter spacing for patrons to disrobe and leave personal items in their respective area.
- After swim patrons are allowed to return to staging area and gather their belongings and proceed to changing room for rinse shower and preparation of street clothes.
- During pandemic showers are for the purpose of rinsing pool water off only and not a full shower. The showers are set up to allow use either with barrier type or for open type a separation of two meter distancing is required as indicated.

- Upon completion of shower and return of street clothes, exit of pool area will be via change room exit doors to lobby second floor. The number of patrons preparing to redress and exit pool area will be monitored so as to facilitate physical distancing and number of patrons. This could possibly require some wait time, depending on number of patrons.
- Users are encouraged to bring their own alcohol-based (60-70 percent) hand sanitizer to be used after touching surfaces within the change room area.
- Drinking fountains will not be available for use.
- All common surfaces will be sanitized by staff after each swim session in preparation for next use.
- Sauna is deemed out of use during the present pandemic level.
- Users are not permitted to store equipment on premises or have personal effects in lockers at this time.
- Exit from pool lobby is recommended thru exit doors second level if possible weather permitting. If not main lobby exit is permissible if outside stairs are hazardous or not preferred. Face coverings are required at all times while leaving premises.
- Please follow and adhere to all posted guidelines and rules in pool area. Also follow marked travel direction arrows etc. and occupancy numbers for change rooms.

Orange Level additions or modifications

- 1/ All users will be actively screened by staff before entrance to pool deck.
- 2/ All users will be subjected to temperature check before entry to pool deck
- 3/ Use of showers will be off limits during orange phase. Change rooms for redress and exit only

Thank you for your ongoing support and collaboration as we work towards a safe return to pool use at the centre.

*Note: As the COVID-19 pandemic and applicable Public Health guidance is constantly evolving, this document and the requirements outlined within may be amended at the discretion of the City of Campbellton. Amended versions will be circulated to user groups as soon as they become available.*
